ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 2-98

AN ORDINANCE TO ACKNOWLEDGE THAT ORDINANCE NO. 2-98 WHICH ESTABLISHED REQUIREMENTS AND PERMITS FOR ALARM SYSTEMS AND FALSE ALARM SERVICE CHARGES HAS NOT BEEN ENFORCED OR OTHERWISE IMPLEMENTED; AND TO REPEAL SAID ORDINANCE AS NO LONGER NECESSARY.

GLEN ARBOR TOWNSHIP HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Acknowledgment of non-enforcement of alarm system permitting and false alarm service charges.

The Township hereby acknowledges that installation permits for alarm systems and devises as described by Ordinance No. 2-98 has not been issued for at least the last 15 years. Furthermore, the Township acknowledges that false alarm service charges have not been collected for at least the last 15 years. Finally, the Glen Lake Fire Department recommends that said ordinance be repealed.

Section 2. Repeal of Ordinance No. 2-98.

Township Ordinance No. 2-98 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be effective on the day following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the township.


