**Informational Open House to Discuss Stream Crossing Improvement Project**

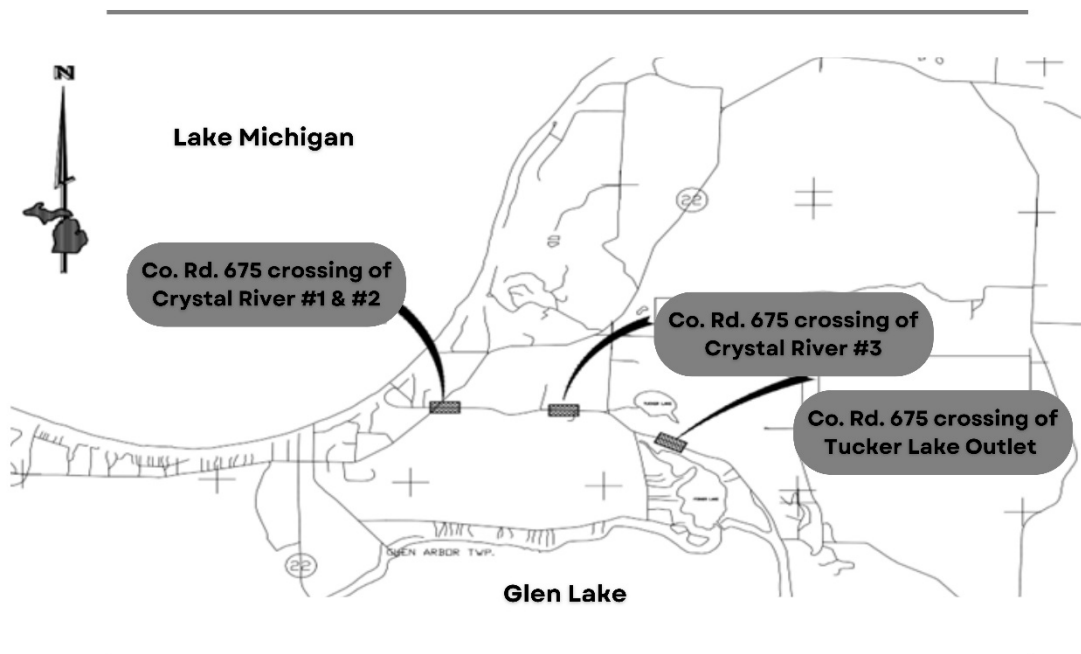
**When:** Thursday, October 27, 2022, 6:30 to 8:00 p.m.
