We are now offering Online Permitting!

Glen Arbor Township now uses a cloud-based software [Cloudpermit](#) so that you can complete the land use permit process online. With Cloudpermit, you can:

- Apply for land use permits at any time online*.
- Check the status of your land use permit (when your application status changes, you will automatically receive an email letting you know)
- Communicate with your Zoning Administrator with time-stamped messages.
- Request and submit changes to an existing land use permit.
- Schedule or cancel inspections.

Please check with your Zoning Administrator or Staff to confirm whether you need to obtain a Land-Use Permit before placing any shed on your property. Any shed greater than 200 sq/ft in size will also require a Building Permit.
