n.b. Only two death records for children of Ransom and Ida have been found. This notice corresponds to one of those death records. But since we know that Ransom and Ida were married at Glen Arbor in 1901 and were still living there in 1903 I think it is probable that there was a third child buried at the cemetery for whom no death record was recorded.
