2 Noise Ordinance proposal - Brett Campbell

Campbell would like to have a ceiling sound level included in the Zoning Ordinance. The Commission and Campbell discussed the possibility of a Noise Ordinance.

It was suggested by Roman that Campbell take their current complaint regarding the "River Club" business to the Zoning Administrator or the Township Supervisor.

Hawley commented on the difficulty of enforcing a Noise Ordinance. Roman suggested that the Police do not respond to Township Ordinances. Further discussion ensued between the Commission members and Campbell.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Bill Niswonger suggested Campbell should refer to the Nuisance Ordinance.

COMMISSION MEMBER COMMENTS:

Hawley suggested that the Township should have an Ordinance such as the Firework Ordinance.

Thompson indicated that if you live in a tourist town, expect to deal with all that it encompasses.
